NAPPANEE ELEMENTARY LUNCH CHARGE POLICY

- Student lunches are \$2.25.
- Students may only charge a full meal. Milk, sides, and extra main dishes cannot be charged.
- Payment for a charge is due the next school day along with the second day's payment for a hot lunch (\$2.25 for the charge + \$2.25 for the current day's hot lunch = \$4.50).
- Students may only charge a maximum of \$8.
- Cafeteria personnel will continue to issue reminders and warnings to students and parents regarding their lunch account status, but it is highly recommended that parents sign up for the MealTime low balance email reminder.

- If there are financial problems, please contact the school cafeteria or school secretaries and we will provide you a free/red application and/or assist you with MealTime online set up.
