Just a reminder that all Woodview students will go outside for recess when the wind chill is above ten degrees. Please be sure to dress your child appropriately. Only children with snow pants, boots and gloves will be allowed to play in the snow. Without these items, they will be restricted to the blacktop area.



Students who must remain inside for health reasons must have a note from their parent or guardian. A note is required for each day, not a “blanket note.” After three (3) days, a note from the doctor is required. **Usually, if a child is too sick to go outside for recess, he/she is too sick to be in school.**

### NEWS FROM THE NURSE

We would like to remind parents of the Center for Disease Control recommendations to keep you and your family healthy.

## ATTENDANCE POLICY



In order to have an excused absence, a parent or guardian must call the school to report the absence. After ten free excused absences, all absences are marked unexcused unless we have a doctor note, court note, or funeral card. Everything else is unexcused.

## EAGLEBOTS UPDATE

Both Eaglebots teams competed recently at Franklin Elementary in Logansport against 31 teams. Eaglebots Blue and Eaglebots Red went into the Finals ranked 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> again, pairing up to score an insane 106 (the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest elementary score currently in Indiana), securing the Teamwork Championship for both teams. Blue also won the Excellence Award, for top overall team there (which takes into account their interview, their engineering notebook, their ranking, and their Skills score). They were also the top Skills team, which is comprised of solo driving and coding.



These great accomplishments have ranked Eaglebots Blue 3<sup>rd</sup> in all of Indiana, out of 1,100 teams. Eaglebots Red is right behind them, ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in the State. Speaking of data, the Eaglebots have finished 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in 10 (!!!!) straight competitions dating back to the 2016-2017 season.
