### INFORMATION FOR 2019-2020

The final deadline to request transportation for the 2019-20 school year is July 15, 2019. Any change or request submitted after July 15 may not be accepted for the beginning of the school year. Reminder, for the safety of students, all Kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade student schedules must be consistent.
