FOOD DRIVE 2016

NorthWood High School held its annual food drive during the week of October 24 through October 28. As part of the food drive tradition, the Student Council encouraged a class competition between third-hour teachers. Any non-perishable item was welcomed; however, the food pantries specifically asked NWHS to collect peanut butter, spaghetti sauce, and cereal this year. In order to fuel excitement and target these items, higher point values were assigned to these donations. All the items collected by the Student Council were donated to the Family Christian Development Center and Open Door in Nappanee.

At the end of the competition, Mrs. Demitruk's class came in first, followed by Mrs. Bilinski's Yearbook class. Though the class competition was exciting, the biggest reward was seeing the school corporation unite for a cause and coming away with the Student Hunger Drive award for most items donated per student!

NorthWood HS Student Council was honored to have received one of the highest recognitions from The Student Hunger Drive. With the help of many, we averaged 21.333 pounds of food per student. This was the highest average out of 11 area high schools who participated!

PSAT

This year approximately 300 students took the PSAT/NMSQT on October 19. The PSAT is a *practice* college entrance test, and taking this test is the only way juniors can be entered into the competition for the prestigious title of *National Merit Scholar*. The *National Merit Scholar* designation is awarded to the elite group of eleventh grade students in the State of Indiana and the United States who score the highest on this test. Participating in this test also gives all students the opportunity to increase their overall knowledge and prepare for future success.

Results of this test will be returned to students in December. Students will also receive the test booklet and an analysis of each test question. After reviewing your student's scores, plan to visit www.collegeboard.com for other information that will be of importance to your child's preparation for life after high school.

FREE Math and Science Help

Students that need help with math or science homework can call the Rose-Hulman's Homework Hotline toll free at 1-877-ASK-ROSE. The tutors, who are Rose-Hulman college students, answer calls from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. (Eastern Daylight Time) Sunday through Thursday. Students can also go online to www.ASKROSE.org. Remember, it's a free service and a free call.

Registering for Selective Service

This is an important message for all NWHS male students who are 18 years old. You must register with Selective Service within 30 days of your 18th birthday—it's the law. Registration only takes a few minutes on the Internet at www.sss.gov or a registration card can be picked up at the local post office. All male students wanting to apply for student financial aid must sign up with the Selective Service.

Graduation Test for Juniors and Seniors

Juniors and seniors who have not yet passed the ECA (End of Course Assessment) for either English or algebra will have the opportunity to retest during the month of December. This test serves as the Graduation test for the students graduating in 2017 or 2018.

Jr./Sr. Algebra I ECA December 8 & 9
Jr./Sr. English ECA December 12 & 13

The students who will need to test or retest have been notified, and on November 30, students will be notified as to the dates and times of the testing sessions. **Students who have passed the test previously do not have to retest.**

ATTENTION JUNIORS:

The state of Indiana requires all students in 6th through 12th grades to have the appropriate number of meningococcal conjugate vaccine doses. One dose is required for all students in 6th through 11th grades. A second booster dose is required for students entering 12th grade. This vaccine is a legal requirement for school entry (Indiana Administrative Code 410 IAC 1-1-1) into 12th grade. Documentation showing the required vaccine was given must be returned to NorthWood High School before your student begins their senior year. You may contact your healthcare provider or the Elkhart County Health Department (523-2127) to receive the required vaccine.
