MEDICATION POLICY

Under normal circumstances, students should take all medication before and/or after school hours. Only medication that must be given during the school day will be permitted in the school. The following procedures will be followed:



☞ Medication will not be given without a signed parent permission form and the child's name on the original medicine container.

☞ All medication must be in the original container. This includes both prescription and non-prescription medications. The school will not accept medications in letter envelopes, plastic bags, etc.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

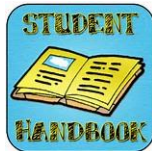


In order to have an excused absence, a parent or guardian must call the school to report the absence. After ten free excused absences, all absences are marked unexcused unless we have a doctor note, court note, or funeral card. Everything else is unexcused.

A Notice of Planned Absence form must be completed and returned to the school office two weeks prior to any extended leave or vacation.

STUDENT HANDBOOK HIGHLIGHT

Student Valuables – Students are encouraged not to bring items of value to school.
