Crisis Mental Health Services

If you or a loved one is in immediate danger, call 911, or go to your nearest emergency room.

Resources that can offer intensive help include the following:

• Beacon Mental & Behavioral Health

Can provide 24/7 assessments and inpatient programs at Elkhart General if over the age of 18 years old

• Goshen Hospital

Can arrange for a crisis assessment 24/7 to determine if inpatient mental health services are needed.

• Memorial Epworth Center

Inpatient psychiatric care division of Memorial Hospital in South Bend, IN. Care provided for adolescents (ages 13 to 17) and adults 18 and older.

• Michiana Behavioral Health Center

Provides assessments and inpatient services—as young as 5 years old Located in Plymouth, IN. Available 24/7

Call emergency services 24/7. During typical business hours, ask for the Access Center and tell them you have a mental health emergency. Oaklawn does not actually have an acute stay option but can assist with getting help
