- ⇒ The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) workshop will be on October 1st at 7:00 pm in the cafeteria. Both Senior parents and students are invited to attend. Students can bring devices and parents will learn how to create a Naviance account.
- ⇒ Many college applications and scholarships require a teacher letter of recommendation. Remember to give teachers at least one week's notice before you need the letter and provide them with an academic resume. You can download a template from the guidance website. All requests must be made through Naviance *after* you have requested the letter in person.

- ◆ It's the only way to qualify for low-interest federal student loans
- ◆ Filing a FAFSA at a college can give you an admissions advantage over those that don't
