PAYING FOR COLLEGE

The INSPIRE Scholarship is designed to provide tuition assistance to graduating high school seniors. Students can earn up to \$3000 per year toward their college education. It is awarded to multiple students seeking both 2-year and 4-year degrees. The selection is weighted on community involvement, work experienced, school attendance, a personal statement and evaluation, and a face-to-face interview. Students must have a GPA between 2.0 and 3.75. Visit inspiringgood.org to apply.
