

COLLEGE INFORMATION

- ⇒ Several applications ask for information from a student transcript. Remember, the most recent transcript can always be viewed under the “Portfolio” tab in Skyward.
- ⇒ Have you already been accepted somewhere? Be sure to check the university’s website to see if they have scholarship applications unique to their university. Also, be sure to update your status in Naviance from “Unknown” to “Accepted”!
- ⇒ Be sure to check with schools to which you have applied to make sure they have all of the proper documents. They don’t usually contact the high school counseling office if they are missing something—they contact the applicant! Make sure you are checking your email regularly as that is how colleges will begin to communicate with you.

To help you pay for your child’s higher education, the federal government offers tuition tax credit programs. A tax credit is an amount that you’re allowed to subtract from what you owe in taxes. There are two different tuition tax credit programs, the American Opportunity tax credit and Lifetime Learning credit. The type and amount varies and is subject to a number of rules, depending on which credit you use and what you use the money for.
