

COLLEGE INFORMATION

- ⇒ Are you interested in going to school out of state? Check to see if the college participates in the [Midwest Student Exchange Program \(MSEP\)](#), a multi-state tuition reciprocity program. Through the MSEP, public institutions agree to charge no more than 150% of the in-state tuition rate and private colleges give a 10% reduction on their tuition rates. Contact the college directly to apply.
- ⇒ Don't let the high costs of private colleges scare you away—only about 10% of students at private institutions actually pay full price for tuition and fees. About 90% of students receive merit-based scholarships and need-based grants to bring the tuition down to an amount that is competitive with most public in-state universities.
- ⇒ IUPUI is offering the first-ever [Bachelor of Arts degree in Artificial Intelligence](#). The curriculum focuses on human-centered computing, computational process automation, and societal impacts of AI. It will prepare students for careers as a User Experience Engineer, AI Assistant Developer, Natural Language Processing developer and bot developer.
