NAPPANEE ELEMENTARY LUNCH CHARGE POLICY

NOTE: You can access your child's food services account through [Skyward Family Access](#). On the Food Services tab, you can see purchase and payment history, add money to your child's lunch account, and apply for assistance for meals and textbook rental.

- Student lunches are \$2.35.
- Student breakfasts are \$1.65.
- Payment for a charge is due the next school day along with the second day's payment for a hot lunch (\$2.35 for the charge + \$2.35 for the current day's hot lunch = \$4.70)
- Charging lunches will not be permitted the last two weeks of the school year.
- Cafeteria personnel will continue to issue reminders and warnings to students and parents regarding their lunch account status, **but it is highly recommended that parents sign up for the Skyward low balance email reminder**. To do this, go to Skyward's home page. In the top righthand corner you will see an Account tab. If you click on it and look under Email Notifications, there is a box you can check to receive notifications for when your child's Food Service Balance is under \$5.00.
- If there are financial problems, you may go to Skyward and fill out a free/reduced application under the Food Services tab.
