What is the Dyslexia Law?

All students in Grades K-2 are required to be screened for dyslexia beginning in the 2019-2020 school year (Senate Enrolled Act No. 217)

In 2015 the Indiana General Assembly passed House Enrolled Act (HEA) 1108. The law put in place an official definition for dyslexia in Indiana. This definition is based on the International Dyslexia Association's definition of dyslexia.
