## **Housing/Utility Assistance**

### 2. Energy Assistance Program:

Apply for state assistance through locally administered REAL Services for your heating bills. Avoid disconnect of heat during the winter months. The program runs from November-March, until the funds run out. To qualify for the program, you must have a social security card for everyone over the age of one in the home. The lease/mortgage must have the name of the person applying for the assistance. There are also income guidelines. Hours: Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri 9-12, & 1:30-4:00 Wed. 9-12 Call first for eligibility and to see what help is available. Can help with utilities when at "disconnect" status, once every 24 months. Can get groceries once every 60 days- up to 4x a year. Can help with medication once every 12 months for up to \$100 per person in the household.
