COLD WEATHER REMINDER

Just a reminder that all Woodview students will go outside for recess when the wind chill is above ten degrees. Please be sure to dress your child appropriately. Only children with snow pants, boots and gloves will be allowed to play in the snow. Without these items, they will be restricted to the blacktop area.

Students who must remain inside for health reasons must have a note from their parent or guardian. A note is required for each day, not a "blanket note." After three (3) days, a note from the doctor is required. Usually, if a child is too sick to go outside for recess, he/she is too sick to be in school.

E-LEARNING/SNOW DAYS

Beginning with our return to school on January 4, students will be bringing home devices on a more consistent

NEWS FROM THE NURSE

We would like to remind parents of the Center for Disease Control recommendations to keep you and your family healthy.
