## **KINDERGARTEN ROUNDUP**

Kindergarten Roundup for next school year began on Monday, March 1<sup>st</sup>. If you haven't yet done so, please initiate the Kindergarten enrollment process by following a link on the corporation website:

After parents have submitted the information sheet, they will be sent an e-mail containing a



link to an informational video, along with enrollment paperwork. Once the office has received completed paper forms, parents will be

contacted by the school office to schedule an appointment in May to have their child assessed. Other documentation required to enroll your student (Birth Certificate, Immunization Record and Proof of Residency) must also be submitted prior to scheduling the assessment. In order to attend kindergarten for next year, students must be five years old on or before August 1, 2022.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

### **INFORMATION FOR 2022-2023**

Bus routes for next school year will be finalized long before your child comes



back to school in August. Therefore, plan to submit your transportation request by the end of this school year. The final deadline to request transportation for the 2022-23 school year is July 15, 2022. Any change or request submitted after July 15 may not be accepted for the beginning of the school year. Reminder, for the safety of students, all Kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade student schedules must be consistent.
