Our Fund Raiser items will now be delivered




on Tuesday, November 1st. Please use the West (Playground) entrance and pick up items between 4:00 and 6:30 p.m. Because of food

Students who must remain inside for health reasons must have a note from their parent or guardian. A note is required for each day, not a "blanket note." After three (3) days, a note from the doctor is required. Usually, if a child is too sick to go outside for recess, he/she is too sick to be in school.
