IMMUNIZATIONS

The Indiana State Department of Health has released Immunization requirements for the 2021-22 school year.

All immunizations should be up-to-date prior to start of the school year.

Indiana 2021-2022 Required and Recommended School Immunizations

- A Avoid *unprotected* UV exposure, seek shade
- W Wear sun protective clothing, a hat and sunglasses
- A Apply sunscreen generously and often
- R Routinely check skin and report changes
- E Educate yourself and others
