not, the office must receive an email, note, or call from the student's guardian giving permission for that person to do so. If you have additional people that you would like to add to Skyward, please log back into your Skyward Family Access, click on online registration, select each student and click on "Mark online registration as not completed and make changes." You can add family members by clicking c. Family Information and emergency contacts by clicking e. Emergency Contacts. Please be sure to mark each tab complete and then submit your online registration when you are done.


FUND RAISER
