We hope your families are doing well as we step into Spring. Thank you in advance for your understanding, flexibility and partnership during the 2020-2021 school year. What a year this has been for everyone and we could not have done it without each and every one of you. This community is truly amazing.

We are excited to share that our WCS staff has been able to take advantage of a Vaccination Clinic for Educators through a partnership with Goshen Community Schools and our local Meijer for which we are extremely grateful.
